<b>Annual Deductible</b> (per calendar year)	None
<b>Maximum Allowable Benefit</b> (per person per calendar year)	None
<b>Diagnostic &amp; Preventive Services</b>	
<i>Oral Exams, Routine Cleanings</i>	No copay (2 per calendar year)
<i>X-rays</i>	No copay (1 initial full mouth, then when diagnostically needed)
<i>Space Maintainers</i>	No copay
<b>Basic Dental Services</b>	
<i>Fillings</i>	No copay (amalgam front/back; composite/resin front only)
<i>Extractions, Endodontics (Root Canal), Periodontics (Gums/Supportive Tissue), Sealants</i>	No copay (sealants up until 4 years of eruption)
<i>Periodontal Scaling, Root Planing</i>	\$11 – one to three teeth per quadrant, \$15 – four or more teeth per quadrant
<b>Major Dental Services</b>	
<i>Crowns (Restorative) Fixed Bridges</i>	\$50 or \$225 copay
<i>Partial &amp; Complete Dentures</i>	\$100 copay each for upper or lower full or partial denture *replacement only after 5 years
<i>Implants (including repair, re-cement, removal)</i>	\$12-\$1860 copay
<i>Orthodontics</i>	\$1,450 for Comprehensive Orthodontic Treatment
