Disaster Unemployment Assistance

Workers who lose their jobs due to no fault of their own, such as in the case of a disaster, may be eligible for Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits

- The quickest and easiest way to apply is online. Visit the Employment Development Department (EDD) website at: www.edd.ca.gov.
 - Click on the “Unemployment” link, then on “Apply for UI” (eApply4UI) at the top right of the page. UI claims also can be filed by telephone at 1-800-300- 5616.

FEMA

*Evacuation Terminology Definitions

- *Evacuation Order*: Immediate threat to life. This is a lawful order to LEAVE NOW. The area is lawfully closed to public access.
- *Evacuation Warning*: Potential threat to life and/or property. Those who require additional time to evacuate, and those with pets and livestock should leave now.
- *Shelter In Place*: Go indoors. Shut and lock doors and windows. Prepare to self-sustain until further notice and/or contacted by emergency personnel for additional direction.
